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MA in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening)

The Department of Education offers MA in Educational Leadership and Management to in-service and pre-service teachers who have completed 14 years of basic education. The degree will focus on developing an effective teacher, with heavy emphasis on understanding teaching methods, teacher and educational leadership, philosophy of education and holistic educational development. The program also meets contemporary national and international trends in the field of educational management and research and is in conformity with the HEC guidelines.

Program Mission

The program envisages knowledge dissemination through critical analysis of theoretical principles in aspects of teacher education and early childhood education. It aims to provide teachers with a professional platform through which they can make informed decisions in the classrooms and emerge as competent practitioners. The program also aims to raise educational standards in the country through a thorough analysis of contemporary educational challenges at the national and international levels and proposes to deal with them through a fine blend of theory and practice.

Program Structure

MA Educational Leadership and Management is a 2 years degree program offered to candidates who wish to pursue teaching as their career. It is a 66 credit hour program with 17 compulsory courses (3 credit hours each), 4 electives (3 credit hours each), and an Action Research Project (3 credit hours). The candidates will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of Teacher Education or Early Childhood Education.

Admission Requirements (MA-ELM)

- The candidate must have 14 years of education with minimum 55% marks/CGPA 2.5 from a university recognized by HEC.

MS in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening)

The MS in Educational Leadership and Management Program at the Department of Education seeks to meet national and international standards of educational study and research. It is in conformity with the HEC guidelines and caters to the interests of a diverse set of learners who have chosen education to be their field of study. It prepares them for practical leadership roles with sound theoretical standing to make informed decisions.

Program Mission

The program aims to produce highly intellectual leaders and managers with influence on educational policy and reform. It envisages identifying challenges in global and local education, addressing issues in education through knowledge and research, and ultimately improving the standards of the prevailing educational system.

Program Structure

The MS in Educational Leadership and Management is a 1.5-2 years program. It is a 30 credit hour program with 6 courses (3 credit hours each), 2 Independent Research Studies (3 credit hours each), and a Thesis (6 credit hours).

The students will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of: Sociology of Education, Educational Policy, Testing/Evaluation, Teacher Education, Professional Development, and Technology.

Admission Requirements (MS-ELM)

- The candidate must have 16 years of education and a B.Ed. degree, with minimum 55% marks/CGPA 2.5 from an HEC recognized institution.
- GAT General with minimum 50% score is also required,
- Last degree verification from HEC required.

All the students are required to complete a 6-week internship program. Working students can produce their current employment record as an alternate to the internship.

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PhD in Educational Leadership and Management (Evening)

The PhD in Educational Leadership and Management program at the Department of Education aspires to meet the growing demand of leaders and managers with expertise in the field of education. There is a strong emphasis on research, and critical awareness on issues of social justice and equity in educational contexts. It equips graduates with the knowledge and skills to have impact on educational policy, reform, and practice.

Program Mission

The program is designed to ensure dissemination and application of synergistic knowledge leading towards making best educational decisions and practices. It aims to equip learners with pedagogical skills dynamically fueled by the process of engagement in local contexts and critical awareness of transnational situations.

Program Structure

The PhD in Educational Leadership and Management is a 3 year program, spread over six semesters. It is a 48 credit hour program comprising 5 courses, 1 Independent Research Study (3 credit hours), and a Dissertation (30 credit hours).

The students will have the opportunity to specialize in the fields of: Sociology of Education, Educational Policy, Testing/Evaluation, Teacher Education, Professional Development, and Technology.

Admission Requirements

- A candidate must have 18 years of education in the relevant discipline, i.e. an MS or M.Phil. in education or educational leadership and management, with minimum
- 60% marks/CGPA 3.00 from an HEC recognized institution.
- GAT subject with minimum 60% score.
- Last degree verification from HEC required.
