MS (Project Management) Program

SZABIST offers MS in Project Management (MSPM) program equivalent to M.Phil. The purpose of this program is to provide research based project management education, related to a student's field of interest. By providing the requisite skills and knowledge, the program lays the foundation for students planning to pursue doctoral studies. The program also allows the SZABIST MPM program graduates to join the MSPM program by completing two core courses and two IS studies to complete MSPM degree. The Students, however, are required to surrender MPM degree to qualify for a transfer of maximum six courses towards MSPM program.

Admissions Requirements

MPM (Masters in Project Management)

The candidate must have a 4 years professional degree/16 years of education with minimum 55% marks/CGPA 2.50 from an HEC recognized institution.

Last Degree verification by Higher Education Commission (HEC) is required.

MS (Project Management)

The candidate must have a 4 years professional degree/16 years of education with minimum 55% marks/CGPA 2.50 from an HEC recognized institution. MS Candidates are also required to pass GAT (General) Exam with minimum 50% score

Last Degree verification by Higher Education Commission (HEC) is required.

Admission Test and Interview

All candidates need to clear the admission test and interview to qualify for admission.

Degree Requirements

1. Completed at least 33 credit hours for MPM and 30 credit hours for MSPM.
2. Maintained minimum CGPA 2.50 for MPM and 2.75 for MSPM.
3. Completed required project (MPM Only).
4. Completed core, compulsory, elective courses and Independent Studies (as applicable to a program).
